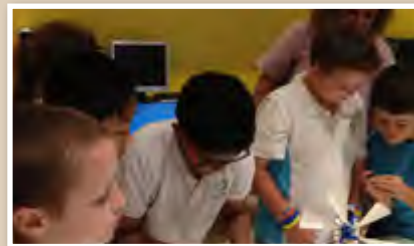
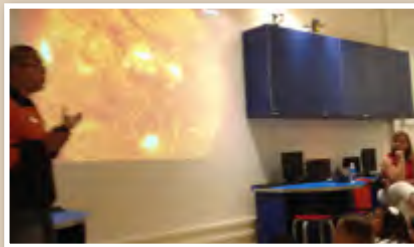


## Grade 4 Newsletter

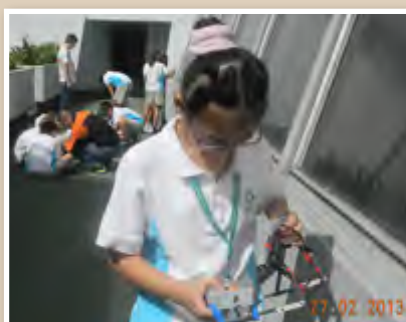
### Mathematics
