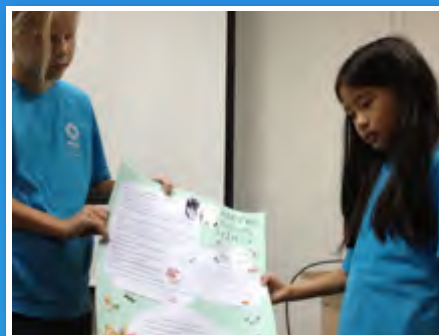
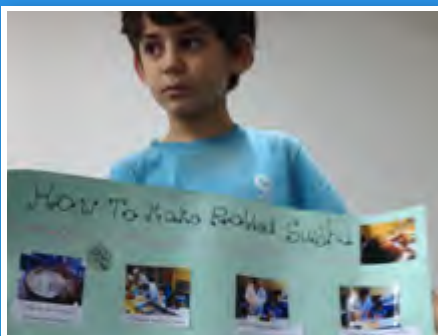
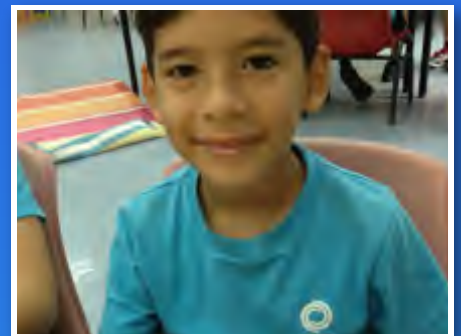


Jungle Book Rehearsals

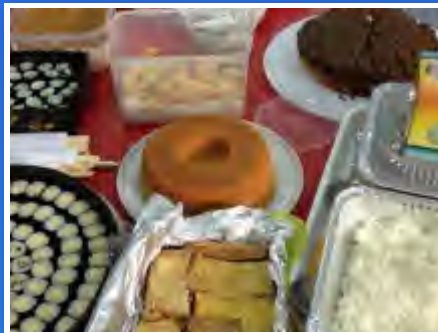
Literacy, UOI and ICT

Presentations

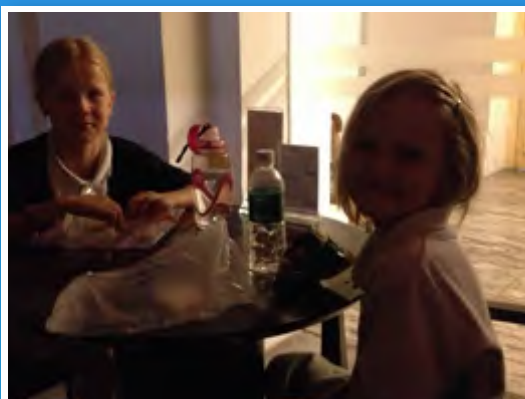
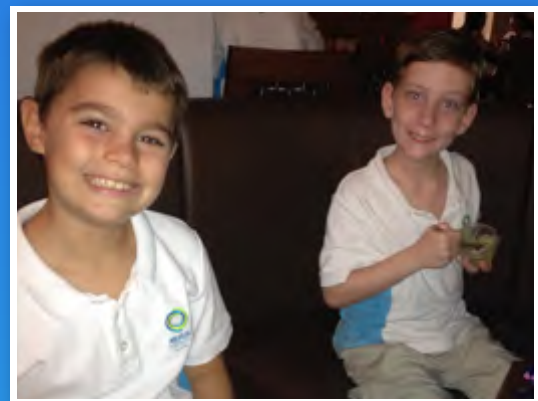
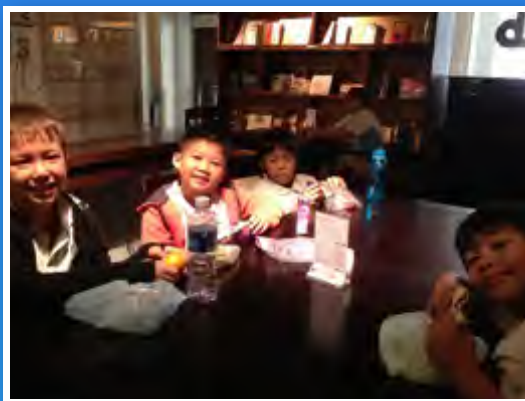
